In Albuquerque, **Park Fine Art** hosts a reception for the Korea Fine Arts Association. The An-Yang branch group show features work by 60 artists from Korea. There's a reception tomorrow night from 5-8pm. Park Fine Art is at 20 First Plaza in the Galeria.

Next door, **Concetta D Gallery** hosts their annual Holiday Open House and group show that includes a collection of specially-priced artwork, ideal for Holiday giving. There's a reception, also tomorrow, from 5-8pm.

Ruth Morris is an Albuquerque doll maker, and you can see her unique work in a show titled "New Tribes" at **Sumner & Dene** in downtown Albuquerque. There's a reception tomorrow from 5-8pm. The gallery is at 517 Central NW.

The **Corrales Bosque Gallery** presents its annual holiday show called "Bosque Twilight." There is a reception tomorrow night from 5-8pm at the gallery, at 4685 Corrales Road.

It's time once again for the **Placitas Holiday Fine Arts and Crafts Fair**. This year they're celebrating their 30th anniversary with 82 artists and artisans from throughout the Southwest. The event takes place at three locations in the village. It takes place Saturday and Sunday from 10-5. Take exit 242 from I-25 and head east on Highway 165. Follow the signs for six miles.

Also in Placitas the **Placitas Artist Series** hosts a reception for its latest exhibition, this one featuring Karen Halbert, Ann Pollard, Marcia Rackstraw, and Marilyn Stablein. There's a reception Sunday from 5-6pm at the Placitas Presbyterian Church, on Highway 165 in Placitas.

And nearby **Clear Light Cedar Company** hosts its annual "Christmas at Clear Light Show" featuring all manner of art and folk art. It takes place Saturday and Sunday. Clear Light is at 686 Highway 165, also in Placitas.
